

**LINWOOD COMMON COUNCIL  
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
April 24, 2013**

**FLAG SALUTE:**

Councilman Tim Tighe led the flag salute.

**CALL TO ORDER**

Council President Taylor called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M., noting that the meeting had been advertised in compliance with the requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES WITHOUT FORMAL READING**

Councilman Beinfest motioned, seconded by Councilman Gordon, to approve the minutes of the April 10, 2013 Regular meeting without formal reading. All members of Council were in favor. Motion was approved.

**ORDINANCES**

**8 OF 2013** AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 221 SEWERS, ARTICLE I, USE OF SEWERS, AND ARTICLE II, SEWER USE AND RATES OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

The Clerk read Ordinance No. 8 of 2013 by title only. Councilwoman DeDomenicis motioned, seconded by Councilman Gordon to approve Ordinance No. 8 for first reading. A roll call vote was heard with seven in the affirmative. Motion was approved.

**9 OF 2013** AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 155 FLOOD HAZARD AREAS OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

The Clerk read Ordinance No. 9 of 2013 by title only. Councilman Beinfest motioned, seconded by Councilwoman DeDomenicis to approve Ordinance No. 9 for first reading. A roll call vote was heard with seven in the affirmative. Motion was approved.
