

ORDINANCE NO. 6, 2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 241 STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, ARTICLE IV DUMPSTERS AND OTHER RECEPTACLES FOR DEBRIS COLLECTION, SECTION 241-21, PERMIT REQUIRED OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 241, Article IV, Section 241-21 Permit required is hereby amended to read as follows:

No container, dumpster, receptacle or other object for the collection of rubbish or debris shall be placed upon any street, sidewalk, public property or private property without a permit issued by the Building Department.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, publication and adoption in the manner prescribed by law.
