

ORDINANCE NO. 8, 2012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 235 SOLID WASTE, ARTICLE II, COLLECTION AND RECYCLING, SECTION 235-7, MANDATORY SEPARATION PROGRAM ESTABLISHED AND SECTION 235-8, SEPARATION OF RECYCLABLES; PLACEMENT FOR DISPOSAL, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 235 Solid Waste, Article II, Collection and Recycling, Section 235-7, Mandatory Separation Program Established is hereby amended to include the following:

- E. Leaves, grass, and brush
- F. Plastic Bottles and Jugs imprinted with a "1" or "2"
- G. White Goods
- H. Asphalt and Concrete
- I. Propane Tank
- J. Consumer Electronics
- K. Motor oil, Kerosene, and #2 home heating oil
- L. Anti-freeze
- M. Sealed lead acid (SLA) batteries
- N. Consumer Rechargeable Batteries
- O. Tires
- P. Paper Products

SECTION 2: Chapter 235 Solid Waste, Article II, Collection and Recycling, Section 235-8, Separation of recyclables; placement for disposal is hereby amended as follows:

- A. The recyclable materials designated in [235-7](#) of this article shall be put in a suitable container, separate from other solid waste, and placed at the curb or such other designated area for collection at such times and dates as may be hereinafter established in the municipality's recycling regulations. The container for recyclable materials shall be clearly labeled and placed at the curb or such other designated area for each collection.
- B. DELETE

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 4: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, publication and adoption in the manner prescribed by law.
