

**LINWOOD COMMON COUNCIL  
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
October 14, 2015**

**FLAG SALUTE:**

Councilman Todd Gordon led the flag salute.

**CALL TO ORDER**

Council President Tim Tighe called the meeting to order at 6:37 P.M., noting that the meeting had been advertised in compliance with the requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act.

**ROLL CALL**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES WITHOUT FORMAL READING**

Councilwoman DeDomenicis motioned, seconded by Councilman Matik, to approve the minutes of the September 24, 2015 Regular meeting without formal reading. All present members of Council were in favor with one abstention by Councilman Heun. Motion was approved.

**RESOLUTIONS WITHIN CONSENT AGENDA**

Councilman Heun – Councilman Heun advised that the gas company work continues and reminded everyone to drive safely.
