

ORDINANCE NO. 14, 2011

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20, 2008, AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES TO THE CITY OF LINWOOD FOR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SPILL CLEAN-UPS FROM MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 2 of Ordinance 20, 2008, is hereby amended to add the following:

The City, at its sole discretion, shall have the authority to authorize and designate the Linwood Fire Department to complete and process the billing.

SECTION 2: Section 5 of Ordinance 20, 2008, is hereby amended to add the following:

The Public Safety Committee of the City of Linwood shall determine how the funds collected shall be distributed and allocated.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 4: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, publication and adoption in the manner prescribed by law.
