

ORDINANCE NO. 14, 2012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 172 LICENSED OCCUPATIONS, ARTICLE II, HOME RENOVATION AND ALTERATION MECHANICS, SECTION 172-3, LICENSE REQUIRED, SECTION 172-5, ISSUANCE OF LICENSE AND ARTICLE III, COMMERCIAL LANDSCAPERS, SECTION 172-13 B, LICENSE FEES; RENEWALS; MAXIMUM NUMBER AND DISPLAY OF DECALS OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 172 Licensed Occupations, Article II, Home Renovation and Alteration Mechanics, Section 172-3, License Required and Section 172-5, Issuance of License are hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 172-3. License required.

Effective January 1, 2006, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to engage in the repairing, replacing, remodeling, renovating or altering of existing construction or equipment of any kind in the City of Linwood, New Jersey, unless such person, firm, association or corporation shall furnish the Construction Code Official of this City a certificate of insurance and a copy of their current valid State of New Jersey Contractor License certifying that such person, firm, association or corporation is qualified to engage in said business.

§ 172-5. Issuance of license.

The Construction Code Official of the City of Linwood is hereby authorized to issue any such license for nonresidential construction upon the delivery to him of said certificate of insurance and payment of the license fee, as herein provided. Every such license shall expire on the 31st day of December of each year. If there is a change in the business location of the licensee, the Construction Code Official shall be notified and the new address shall be noted on the license.

SECTION 2: Chapter 172 Licensed Occupations, Article III, Commercial Landscapers Section 172-13, B. License fees; renewals; maximum number and display of decals is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. License renewals must be received no later than May 31 to be eligible as a renewal. Those applied for after May 31 will be considered as a new license and are subject to the two-hundred-dollar new license fee.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 4: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, publication and adoption in the manner prescribed by law.
