

DECLARATION OF MAYOR AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
COORDINATOR
CITY OF LINWOOD
March 26, 2020

As a result of the Corona Virus Pandemic and its significant impact upon the residents of the State of New Jersey, including but not limited to Southern New Jersey and the City of Linwood; and as a further result of the State of Emergency declared by Governor Phil Murphy of the State of New Jersey, a Declaration is being issued by Darren Matik in his capacity as the Mayor and Emergency Management Coordinator of the City of Linwood. Commencing on March 26, 2020, the enforcement of all ordinances of the City of Linwood related to the issuance of residential rental Certificates of Occupancy and municipal inspections related thereto shall temporarily be suspended until such time as the Governor lifts the State of Emergency. This suspension of the enforcement of the subject ordinances is being done in order to allow the public ample and sufficient opportunity to secure necessary residential housing and shelter needs. This suspension is not intended to apply to the enforcement of any ordinances related to imminently dangerous or life threatening situations. A copy of this Declaration shall be forthwith provided to the Municipal Prosecutor and Municipal Court Judge of the Linwood Northfield Shared Courts.
