RESOLUTION NO. 121, 2016

A RESOLUTION APPROVING TEMPORARY SIGNAGE FOR UNLOCK ESCAPE ROOMS

WHEREAS, the owner of Unlock Escape Rooms has requested permission for one temporary sign, measuring 9' tall, approximately 27" at its widest point, advertising the opening of their new business at Central Square, 199 New Road, Unit #70 in the City of Linwood; and

WHEREAS, temporary signage needs approval by City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council is desirous of approving said request;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, that permission for the placement of one temporary sign, measuring 9' tall, approximately 27" at its widest point, advertising the opening of their new business is hereby granted to Unlock Escape Rooms based on the following conditions;

- 1.) Signs shall not be internally illuminated or electrically activated.
- 2.) Signs shall not be in the Right-of-way on New Road.
- 3.) Signs shall not block any site triangle for access and egress points of travel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the signs shall be permitted for a period of two weeks beginning on July 29, 2016 and ending on August 12, 2016.

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A REDEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE IN THE CITY OF
LINWOOD

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Linwood is desirous of establishing a Redevelopment Committee and setting forth the number and terms of the members and the procedure for appointments thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood that a Redevelopment Committee is hereby established with three members including the Mayor, one Council Member and a third person who can be either a Council Member or an individual citizen, at the discretion of the Council President;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appointments shall be made by the Council President on an annual basis;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the initial members of the committee shall be Mayor Richard L. DePamphilis, III, Councilman Eric Ford and Timothy W. Tighe. All of said appointments shall be until December 31, 2016 or until successors are appointed and said appointments are hereby confirmed by the Common Council.
