ORDINANCE NO. 1, 2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 263 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE I GENERAL REGULATIONS, SECTION 263-4 PROHIBITED PARKING; STOPPING OR STANDING OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 263, Article I. General Regulations, Section 263-4 Prohibited parking; stopping or standing; time limit parking; snow emergencies; violations and penalties is hereby amended to add the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Maple Avenue	Southwesterly	From a point 75 feet from southeasterly intersection of Maple Avenue and Wabash Avenue
Maple Avenue	Southwesterly	From a point of 50 feet from southeasterly intersection of Maple and Van Sant Avenue
East Wabash Avenue	West	Poplar Avenue to Vernon Avenue
West Wabash Avenue	East	Wilson Avenue to Vernon Avenue

SECTION 2: Chapter 263, Article I. General Regulations, Section 263-9 Stop intersections is hereby amended to add the following:

Intersection	Stop Sign On
Franklin Boulevard and Glenside Avenue	Franklin Boulevard

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 4: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, publication and adoption in the manner prescribed by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF 2024

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING CERTAIN UNEXPENDED PROCEEDS OF THE SALE OF PREVIOUSLY ISSUED BONDS AND NOTES TO FINANCE THE COST OF ADDITIONAL RECREATIONAL IMPROVEMENTS AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic, New Jersey ("**City**") has, pursuant to the Local Bond Law, Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes, as amended and supplemented ("**Local Bond Law**"), and the Bond Ordinance No. 10-2011, finally adopted on August 10, 2011; Bond Ordinance No. 13-2012, finally adopted on July 11, 2012; Bond Ordinance No. 12-2014, finally adopted on June 25, 2014; Bond Ordinance No. 14-2014, finally adopted on July 9, 2014; Bond Ordinance No. 6-2015, finally adopted on June 10, 2015; Bond Ordinance No. 6-2017, finally adopted on April 26, 2017; Bond Ordinance No. 4-2018, finally adopted on February 14, 2018; Bond Ordinance No. 9-2018, finally adopted on June 12, 2018; Bond Ordinance No. 9-2019, finally adopted on April 24, 2019; and Bond Ordinance No. 3-2020, finally adopted on March 11, 2020, in all respects duly approved and published as required by the law (collectively, the "**Bond Ordinances**"), authorized, issued and sold its general obligation bonds ("**Obligations**") to finance the costs of various capital improvements within the City, as more fully described in the Bond Ordinances (the "**Prior Projects**"); and

WHEREAS, payment of all of the costs of the Prior Projects under the Bond Ordinances have been made or provided for and \$268,000 of the proceeds of the sale of the Obligations for the Prior Projects are not necessary for such purposes and remain unexpended ("**Unexpended Proceeds**"); and

WHEREAS, Section 40A:2-39 of the Local Bond Law provides that, if, in the opinion of the City Council of the City ("**Council**"), it is in the best interest of the City, the Unexpended Proceeds may be appropriated to and used to finance the cost of any other purpose or purposes for which bonds may be issued; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to appropriate the Unexpended Proceeds towards the costs of various recreational improvements within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Appropriation of Unexpended Proceeds. It is hereby determined that, in the opinion of Council, it is in the best interest of the City to appropriate the Unexpended Proceeds in the amount of **\$268,000** under the Bond Ordinances to finance the costs associated with various general recreational improvements

(collectively, the “**Additional Recreation Improvements**”), and accordingly, said sum is hereby appropriated, which Unexpended Proceeds shall be used for the costs associated with the Additional Recreation Improvements for the City.

Section 2. Capital Budget Amendment. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital improvement program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the City Clerk and are available for public inspection.

Section 3. No Additional Indebtedness Authorized. This Ordinance does not authorize any additional indebtedness, but merely appropriates proceeds of obligations in excess of the amount required to complete the improvements for the financing of which such obligations were originally issued.

Section 4. Repeal of Inconsistent Legislation. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof to the extent inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or rescinded.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 4, 2024

**AN ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS
AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40:A:4-45.1., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Linwood in the County of Atlantic finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2024 budget up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$327,312.03 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated, as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriating in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, in the County of Atlantic, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring that, in the CY 2024 budget year, the final appropriations of the City of Linwood shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14, be increased by 3.5% amounting to \$327,312.03, and that the CY 2024 municipal budget for the City of Linwood be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the

Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

Dear Mr. Ford and Council Members:

On Friday, March 22, 2024, at 10:00 A.M., sealed bids were received by The City of Linwood for the "Mainland Pond Improvements" Contract No. 49. A total of four (4) contractors picked up bid documents during the bidding period and four (4) contractors submitted bids for the project. The bids are tabulated below in order from the lowest to the highest for the total bid:

Bidders Name	Bid
Capela Construction	\$ 34,500.00
West Bay Construction	\$ 48,500.00
Command Company	\$ 58,000.00
Arthur R. Henry	\$ 73,300.00

All of the bids have been checked for administrative completeness and math computations. The Engineer's Estimate for the bid was \$40,000.00. The lowest bid for the project submitted by Capela Construction, Inc. is approximately 13% below the Engineer's Estimate for the bid.


Based on an analysis of the bids received, the Engineer's Estimate and total project costs; the bid submitted by Capela Construction, Inc. is the lowest responsive bid and appears favorable to the City.

Subject to the appropriation of City funds, we recommend awarding the Contract in the amount of \$34,500.00 to Capela Construction, Inc., of Medford Lakes, NJ.
