



Upon consideration of the consent of the parties for this Consent Order for settlement, and good cause appearing therefore, it is on FEBRUARY 15th, 2023 ORDERED that:

1. Defendant, Susquehanna Bank a/k/a Branch Banking & Trust Company n/k/a Truist Bank, has paid the sum of ONE-HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX THOUSAND (\$176,000.00) DOLLARS to Honig & Greenberg Attorney Trust Account for the benefit of the Plaintiff. This sum is in full satisfaction of any and all claims by Plaintiff against the Defendants and against the

Property located at 21 Georgetown Court, Linwood City, Atlantic County, Block 29.01, Lot 7.08.

2. In consideration of the relief set forth herein, Defendants expressly, unequivocally, and unconditionally waive and release any and all claims that Defendants have or may claim to have against the Plaintiff, its agents, servants, employees, heirs or assigns, including any claims that may exist or may thought to exist against Plaintiff's counsel, from the beginning of the world to the date of this Consent Order. Specifically, Defendants hereby release and forever discharge the Plaintiff, and their respective officers, directors, shareholders, partners, attorneys, predecessors, successors, representatives, insurers, assignees, agents, employees and all persons acting by, through or in any way on behalf of the Plaintiff (collectively the "Plaintiff"), of and from any and all claims, debts, defenses, liabilities, costs, attorney fees, actions, suits at law or equity, demands, contracts, expenses, damages, whether general, specific or punitive, exemplary, contractual or extra-contractual, and causes of action of any kind or nature that Defendants may now have or claim to have against the Plaintiff, including without limitation all claims or causes of action which in any way, directly or indirectly, or in any other way arise from or are connected with or which could


have been asserted in connection with the Property or otherwise. Defendants further covenant and agree that this Agreement may be pleaded or asserted by or on behalf of the Plaintiff as a defense and complete bar to any action or claim that may be brought against or involving the Plaintiff by anyone acting or purporting to act on behalf of Defendant with respect to any of the matters within the scope of this Agreement excepting only the obligations of the Parties under this Agreement. This full and final release shall cover and shall include and does cover and does include any and all known or future damages not now known to any of the Parties hereto, but which may later develop or be discovered, including the effects and consequences thereof, and including all causes of action therefore which arise out of any of the matters within the scope of this Agreement excepting only the obligations of the Parties under this Agreement.

3. In addition, Plaintiff and Defendant hereby release each other from any and all claims of any kind, from the beginning of the world to the date of this Order, including but not limited to any claims under N.J.S. 54:5-63.1, N.J.S. 54:5-54.1, or otherwise.
4. Based upon the above payment, the Final Judgment entered in this matter on April 6, 2022 and recorded with the County Clerk on June 7, 2022 in Deed Book 15244 Instrument 2022029254

is vacated, this case is dismissed with prejudice, and title is re-vested in Asuncion Ciceron.

5. The mortgage held by Defendant, Susquehanna Bank a/k/a Branch Banking & Trust Company n/k/a Truist Bank, which mortgage was recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Atlantic County on October 4, 2013 at Instrument Number 2013062453 shall be and hereby is revived as a valid mortgage lien against the subject property herein.
6. Tax sale certificate number 19-00022 is declared to have been redeemed by the payment set forth herein. The Tax Collector for the municipality shall mark this certificate as redeemed upon the municipal records, and the County Clerk shall mark the recorded certificate, appearing in Mortgage Book 14623 as Instrument 2019031248, as canceled by Court Order. Redemption having taken place pursuant to Court Order, the municipality shall promptly refund the premium to Plaintiff in accordance with law.
7. Counsel for Plaintiff may release the monies set forth above to the Plaintiff.

8. The Deputy Clerk of the Superior Court shall affix the raised seal of the Superior Court upon this Order and a certified copy of this Order shall be recorded by the Defendant with the Clerk of Atlantic County to effectuate the re-vesting of title in the Defendant.



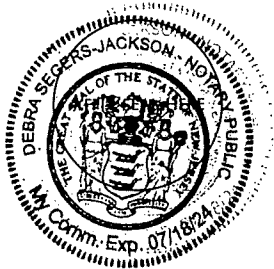
