ORDINANCE NO. 18, 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 221 SEWERS, ARTICLE I USE OF SEWERS OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 221, Article I. Use of Sewers, Section 221-19 Connection; fees, Section C is hereby amended to read as follows:

- C. If in fact a property was previously connected to sewer and, as a result of fire, casualty or demolition becomes disconnected, if said property is reconnected within two years of the disconnection, the connection fee shall only be \$300. If reconnection occurs after a two year time of disconnection, the connection fee shall be \$1,850.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, publication and adoption in the manner prescribed by law.
