ORDINANCE NO. 11, 2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 183 NUISANCES, ARTICLE I, PROHIBITED USES OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 183, Section 183-1 Prohibited uses, B. Noise (2) Definition of noise, is hereby amended as follows:

Delete (j) in its entirety

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, publication and adoption in the manner prescribed by law.

RESOLUTION NO. 188, 2024

A RESOLUTION APPROVING TEMPORARY SIGNAGE FOR MAINLAND JR. WRESTLING

WHEREAS, Mainland Jr. Wrestling has requested permission for temporary signage along the bike path and in All Wars Memorial Park; and

WHEREAS, Mainland Jr. Wrestling has requested ten lawn signs with sign up information from November 21, 2024 to December 5, 2024; and

WHEREAS, temporary signage needs approval by City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council is desirous of approving said request;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the sponsorship signs shall be permitted for a period beginning on November 21, 2024 and ending on December 5, 2024.

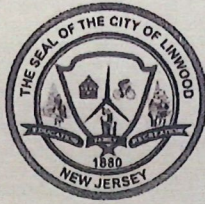

Temporary Sign Application

Linwood City Code Chapter 197 Parks & Recreation Areas
197-12 Signs and advertising materials

"It shall be unlawful for any person to paste, glue, tack or otherwise post any sign, plaque or advertisement or inscription whatsoever, nor shall any person erect, or cause to be erected, any sign whatsoever on any public land or highway or roads adjacent to said park or playground or highway or roads adjacent to said park or playground area unless otherwise authorized by the City of Linwood. However, the temporary placement of signs for advertising purposes may be allowed on the left and the right outfield fences surrounding the Little League field, the fence located next to the soccer field, and the fence located next to the football field. The aforementioned signs shall be permitted only by approval from Linwood City Council in accordance with conditions and regulations as may be determined and promulgated by the Linwood City Council."
