

CITY OF LINWOOD BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN PLAN

The City of Linwood is preparing a Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan with the assistance from the consulting firm of Michael Baker Jr., Inc. The Plan is sponsored by the New Jersey Department of Transportation, Office of Bicycle and Pedestrian Programs.

The Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan will identify bicycle and pedestrian issues in the community, and recommend different treatments to promote bicycle and pedestrian safety, accessibility, and mobility in Linwood. As one example, the study will consider the development of east-west links from the Linwood Bike Path. The final product of this study will be a Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan which will serve as both a guide to develop City projects, and as a resource to obtain funding for the implementation of bicycle and pedestrian improvements.

Residents and workers in Linwood are encouraged to provide input to the Plan. A representative of Michael Baker will be present to discuss the Plan at the Linwood Country Fair at All Wars Memorial Park, Shore Road this Saturday, May 7, from 10 AM to 4 PM.
