ORDINANCE NO. 8, 2023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 263 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE I GENERAL REGULATIONS OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 263, Article I. General Regulations, Section 263-9 Stop intersections is hereby amended to add the following:

**Intersection**

Maple Avenue and Van Sant Avenue

**Stop Sign On**

Northerly side of Maple Avenue for traffic proceeding northbound on Maple Avenue

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, publication and adoption in the manner prescribed by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 9, 2023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 197, PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT THEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that Chapter 197, Parks and Recreation Areas, be and hereby is amended as follows:

SECTION 1:

**Article I Parks and Recreation Areas**

SECTION 2 : Chapter 197, Parks and Recreation Areas, 197-1 Operating policy be and hereby is amended as follows:

Any section or part of the parks or recreation areas hereinafter named may be declared closed to the public by the Mayor of the City of Linwood at any time and for any interval of time, either temporarily or at regular or stated intervals.

SECTION 3 : Chapter 197, Parks and Recreation Areas, 197-2 Permit for group activity be and hereby is amended as follows:

**A.** Whenever any person, group, association or organization desires to use said park facilities for a particular purpose, such as picnics, parties or theatrical or entertainment performances or any other activity, a representative of said person, group, association or organization shall first obtain a permit from the Linwood Board of Recreation.

**B.** The Linwood Board of Recreation shall grant the application, if it appears that the person, group, association or organization meets all of the conditions contained in an application form to be hereinafter provided by the City Council. The application may contain a requirement for an indemnity bond to protect the City from any liability of any kind or character and to protect City property from damage.

SECTION 4 : Chapter 197, Parks and Recreation Areas, 197-6 Use of rest rooms and washrooms be and hereby is amended as follows:

Any person using rest rooms and/or washrooms contained on the park area, shall cooperate in maintaining the rest rooms and/or washrooms in a neat and sanitary condition.

SECTION 5 : Chapter 197, Parks and Recreation Areas, 197-9 Use of vehicles be and hereby is amended as follows:

**A.** It shall be unlawful to drive or park any automobile or other form of motor vehicle, motorcycle, golf cart, e-scooter, scooter, e-bike, minibike or bicycle in the park area or to park or leave any such vehicle on any place other than one established for public parking, unless otherwise authorized by the City of Linwood. Bicycles, e-bikes, scooters, and e-scooters may be permitted to be parked in the park area but only at designated areas for the parking of bicycles. Bicycles and e-bikes may be operated on any path designated for travel in the park area.

**B.** Golf carts may be permitted only for use of an approved sports organization after obtaining authorization from the Linwood Board of Recreation.

SECTION 6 : Chapter 197, Parks and Recreation Areas, 197-12 Signs and advertising materials be and hereby is amended as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to paste, glue, tack or otherwise post any sign, plaque or advertisement or inscription whatsoever, nor shall any person erect, or cause to be erected, any sign whatsoever on any public land or highway or roads adjacent to said park or playground or highway or roads adjacent to said park or playground area unless otherwise authorized by the City of Linwood. However, the temporary placement of signs for advertising purposes may be allowed on the left and the right outfield fences surrounding the Little League field, the fence located next to the soccer field, and the fence located next to the football field. The aforementioned signs shall be permitted only by approval from Linwood City Council in accordance with conditions and regulations as may be determined and promulgated by the Linwood City Council.

SECTION 7: Chapter 197, Parks and Recreation Areas be and hereby is amended to add the following:

The public parks and recreation areas shall be closed from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Use of the athletic fields for sports organizations with approval from the Board of Recreation shall not be subject to the regular hours of operation during the approved use.

SECTION 8: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SECTION 9: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 10: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 10, 2023

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND THE ATLANTIC COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Linwood to enter into a Shared Services Agreement with the Atlantic County Utilities Authority for solid waste collection services to be provided by the Atlantic County Utilities Authority for the City of Linwood; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:14B-49 empowers municipalities and utilities authorities to enter into contracts for the collection, disposal, recycling, processing and treatment of solid waste by means of the solid waste system of the municipal utilities authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Contract.

The City of Linwood shall enter into a Shared Services Agreement with the Atlantic County Utilities Authority for the collection, disposal, recycling, processing and treatment of solid waste by means of the solid waste system of the municipal utilities authority to be provided by the Atlantic County Utilities Authority to the City of Linwood. Said services shall be furnished and rendered pursuant to the Agreement. The City of Linwood shall pay the Atlantic County Utilities Authority in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.

SECTION 2: Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law as well as the adoption of a substantially similar Resolution by the Atlantic County Utilities



Authority and if said Atlantic County Utilities Authority has already adopted such a Resolution, upon passage and publication as provided by law and in accordance with said Agreement.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 4: Should any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PERMIT FOR THE LINWOOD BOARD OF RECREATION FALL FESTIVAL

**WHEREAS**, the Linwood Board of Recreation is hosting a Fall Festival in All Wars Memorial Park October 15, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the festival will include a beer garden at the park and the Linwood Board of Recreation has applied for a Social Affairs Permit through the State of New Jersey for approval of same; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Linwood City Code Chapter 83, Section 29, consumption of alcoholic beverages on public property for special municipal and municipally affiliated events requires City Council approval; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council is desirous of authorizing an Alcoholic Beverage permit for the event;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, that subject to State approval of the Social Affairs Permit, and a Certificate of Liability Insurance naming the City as additional insured by the Linwood Board of Recreation, the Alcoholic Beverage Permit for the Linwood Board of Recreation Fall Festival is hereby approved for October 15, 2023.

THIS PERMIT IS CONDITIONED THAT THE PERMITTEE SHALL NOT SELL, SERVE OR DELIVER, OR ALLOW, PERMIT OR SUFFER THE SALE, SERVICE OR DELIVERY OF ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY TO, OR CONSUMPTION BY ANY PERSON UNDER THE LEGAL AGE TO CONSUME ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, NOR TO ANY PERSON WHO IS ACTUALLY OR APPARENTLY INTOXICATED. SELF SERVICE BY CONSUMERS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED UNDER THE TERMS OF THIS PERMIT. SERVICE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO CONSUMERS MUST BE MADE AND SUPERVISED BY AUTHORIZED STAFF OF THE PERMITTEE. THE PERMITTEE SHALL MAINTAIN ADEQUATE STAFF TO MONITOR EACH DELIVERY OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE TO PREVENT SERVICE TO INTOXICATED OR UNDERAGE INDIVIDUALS.


PERMITTEE MAY PURCHASE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR USE AT THE PERMITTED AFFAIR ONLY FROM LICENSED NEW JERSEY WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS WHOSE LICENSE PRIVILEGE PERMITS THE SALE OF PACKAGE GOODS FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION, EXCEPT THE PERMITTEE, IF A CLUB LICENSEE, MAY USE ITS OWN INVENTORY FOR THE CONDUCT OF THIS EVENT. THIS PERMIT IS CONDITIONED THAT ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PURCHASED AT WHOLESALE AND NOT CONSUMED AT THIS AFFAIR MUST BE RETURNED TO THE WHOLESALER.

PERMITTEE MAY RECEIVE DELIVERY OF THE AFOREMENTIONED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SUBSEQUENT TO ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT WITHIN FOUR DAYS PRIOR TO THE AFFAIR EITHER AT THE PREMISES AT WHICH THE AFFAIR IS TO BE HELD OR AT OTHER PREMISES IN THE POSSESSION OR UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE PERMITTEE, AND TRANSPORT SUCH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES THROUGH ANY DULY LICENSED TRANSPORTER IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY, OR IN ANY VEHICLE OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY THE PERMITTEE, PROVIDED THAT THIS PERMIT OR A COPY THEREOF BE CARRIED BY THE OPERATOR OF SUCH VEHICLE.

THIS PERMIT IS EXPRESSLY SUBJECT TO ALL LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH OR HEREAFTER IMPOSED, AND TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED HERETOFORE AND HEREAFTER BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL. THIS PERMIT MAY BE CANCELED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL IN HIS SOUND DISCRETION AT ANY TIME WITHOUT NOTICE, REASON OR CAUSE.

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM
