
Welcome to the City of Linwood Bike Path

Don'ts

- Block the path by walking 3 to 4 people across when other travelers are trying to pass from behind.
- Release your pet on an extended leash when others are trying to pass.
- Speed or act carelessly on a bicycle, e-bike, scooter, or skateboard.



Do's

- Be courteous to everyone and Share the Path.
- Please stay to the right in the direction traveling to allow others to pass.
- Ensure your pet is on a leash and as close as possible to increase others mobility and safety.
- Maintain a safe speed when traveling on a bicycle, e-bike, or any legal electronic vehicle allowed by NJ Law.
- Walk your bicycle across a crosswalk.
