Call before you dig. For free markouts of underground utility lines, call three (3) full days before you dig.

Be prepared to supply the following information when you call for your markout:

- Your Name and Title
- Telephone Number - Fax Number
- Best Time to Call Back
- Contractor & Contractor's Address
- Work being done for & address
- Dig Location
- County - Municipality - Street Address
- Nearest Intersection
- Type of Work
- Extent of Work
- Start Date - Start Time

Underground utilities are each identified by a different color:

Red	Electric
Yellow	Gas-Oil-Steam
Orange	Communication CATV
Blue	Water
Green	Sewer
Pink	Temporary Survey Marks
White	Proposed Excavation

Do I need a permit for a driveway, sidewalk or curbing?

Yes, the permit is applied for at the Construction Dept. in City Hall.

Application Fee: \$25
Escrow fees (minimum escrow fee \$100)
Curb \$1.50 per lineal foot:
Sidewalk: \$1.00 per lineal

Dumpsters, PODS...

Do I need a permit?
Can they be placed on the street or must it be on my property?

Containers, dumpsters, PODs, receptacles and other objects for the collection or storage of rubbish and debris or storage of items during construction or moving, placed on any street, sidewalk or public property must be obtain a permit. Anyone desiring a permit must make written application to the Construction Dept. which includes the following information:

- Name & Address of Applicant
- Exact proposed location of dumpster, etc.
- Length of time use is required up to a maximum of 6 months per calendar year.
- Circumstances necessitating the need

Dumpsters/Containers on any street, sidewalk or public property must be equipped with suitable reflectors or other warning devices.

Application Fee: \$50.00 per month
Dumpsters/Containers, etc. parked on a street, sidewalk or public property require an **indemnity deposit of \$500.00**

(to reimburse the city for the cost of any extraordinary cleanup or repair which may be incurred by the city)
